Dear Parents/Guardians

Your son has been selected to attend the North Hertfordshire U11 (Year 6 for 2019/2020) District football trials. The trials will take place on Friday 6th September at Greneway School, Royston (SG87JF) on grass pitches from 4.00 pm to 5.30 pm. Following the trials a final squad of 14 players will be selected to represent the District.

Your son has already been identified as a talented performer within his school and could now potentially be selected to represent North Herts. However a large number of players are expected at the trials and it will not be possible for all boys who attend the trials to then be selected in the final squad.

For the trials your son will need shorts, football socks, shin pads, football boots, a suitable training top and plenty to drink.

If your son is unable to attend on the date of the trials please let me know so they can still be considered in the future.

The squad selected will be involved in approximately three training sessions, two friendlies, the Hertfordshire Inter District 9 a-side tournament and the Hertfordshire Inter District 7 a-side tournament, which can then potentially lead to the Regional and National finals. Once the squad is selected the dates for all events and fixtures will be distributed to parents.

I appreciate that it is likely that many of the boys are already involved in a lot of football and may already have prior commitments to training etc with their schools, clubs, academy sides. Recently we have had a number of players at clubs and academies including Spurs, Arsenal, West Ham and Milton Keynes as well as local teams where the clubs have been very accommodating in allowing players to attend District sessions. We hope to continue to expand and develop these relationships. The District set up is not designed to take the place of the pupils existing commitments but to work alongside them where possible. Please feel free to email me if you have any questions.

Representing your District is seen as an honour and can potentially open the door to many more opportunities within football. There will be a number of scouts at our fixtures and as a District organisation we have a number of clubs who have developed close links to us where we can arrange for potential trials when appropriate.
