ESSENTIAL INFORMATION FOR PARENTS

<u>SUGGESTED KIT LIST: -</u>TO BE CARRIED IN 1 SUITCASE/BAG AND 1 PIECE OF HAND LUGGAGE

- 1. Sufficient long or ankle socks (Not trainer socks) and underwear for 3 days.
- 2. At least 3 **long-sleeved** t-shirts/shirts/blouses for activities where possible make these old clothes
- 3. At least 3 pairs of trousers/tracksuit bottoms for activities (NO JEANS)
- 4. Clothes for non-activity down time (Meals etc.)
- 5. Light sweaters and 1 thick jumper
- 6. Shorts & t-shirts
- 7. Swimwear for water sports
- 8. Waterproof anorak/cagoule
- 9. Nightwear
- 10. Indoor shoes or slippers
- 11. Trainers/plimsolls (they are likely to get very wet and muddy on the assault course and during water sports). At <u>least</u> 2 pairs (this includes a separate pair for water sports)
- 12. Toilet bag flannel, toothbrush, toothpaste, soap shampoo, comb, hairbrush, 1 or 2 press on towels for girls. Any deodorant <u>must</u> be a roll-on or stick type (no aerosols)
- 13. 2 Towels
- 14. Waterproof trousers (OPTIONAL but very useful)
- 15. Sun hat/Cap
- 16. Walking boots (OPTIONAL)

OTHER ITEMS NEEDED:-

- 1. Sleeping bag and pillow case (In suitcase if possible)
- 2. Drink bottle
- 3. Sun lotion!
- 4. Torch
- 5. Several strong waterproof bags for packing wet and muddy boots and clothes to go home in
- 6. Small activity for journey/free time e.g. books, packs of cards, small game, notebook
