To help support us, please talk to your child about their journey to and from school, and how to stay safe. We have amended our duties to place a member of staff on the opposite side of the road to manage students as they exit. Buses parked in the layby cause a blind spot, but we will be monitoring all situations.

Year 5

Last year, a significant amount of work went into reducing bullying and poor behaviour within the school. As part of this, all our reviews and inspections recognised the "good behaviour of the students". This involved the school, students and parents being clear about what 'bullying' is and what it is not.

At Edwinstree we define 'bullying' as 'repeated behaviours that leave another feeling harmed and/or upset'.

We do not tolerate bullying and I have, and will continue to exclude any student who persistently harms another student, either mentally or physically. Older students and parents can testify to this.

We also worked hard last year to get rid of the idea "that you don't snitch on others". Students in the older year groups are clear this is only used to allow the bullies to continue bullying, and that everyone at their age needs help and support to deal with the problem.

After half term we will devote a PSHCE lesson to ensuring Year 5 are clear what is 'bullying' and what it is not, that it is always important to get help and tell someone when there is a problem. If you can help us by notifying us immediately of a problem – we will act swiftly and effectively.
