

What do I need to bring in next week to participate in the Myanmar challenge?

Year 7, next week you will be challenged to pit your skills against the Myanmar street children. Below are the things you need to bring in to carry out your challenges:

Challenge A to build a model slum dwelling from collected rubbish.

If you are completing the model house building exercise – **you will need to bring in as much washed rubbish as you can, to build a model slum dwellers house, which will be roughly the size of a show box. Here are some pictures to help you think about what to bring. Remember, you cannot glue or sellotape on your rubbish and it will be tested for earthquake proof ability at the end.**



Challenge 2 – To carry out a street child’s daily job.

You will be making paper bags for a market seller, they are ruthless and will only pay for the best quality paper bags to place their produce in. The market seller will provide the glue, but you must bring the recycled paper. **You will need a lot of recycled paper per person, one read newspaper would work!**

Monday- Working with Mrs Gant - **7R period 3 Make sure you bring rubbish to make your model house Challenge 1.**

Tuesday – Working with Mrs Gant - **7F and 7R period 2 please bring your recycled paper – you will need a newspapers amount. You will be completing challenge 2.**

Wednesday – **Working with Mrs Gant is 7S period 4, please bring your recycled paper for Challenge 2.**

Thursday – **Working with Mrs Gant is 7C and 7F, please bring your rubbish to make your model house Challenge! .**
