Times are broken into AM and PM slots which operate from the start of the day until 11:30am for AM session and 11:30pm to the end of the day for PM session. The AM also includes a welcome and settling activity in the morning and PM their Collective Worship [COWO]. While in total students are down 15 minutes on their normal lesson time to the end of the day, they are not travelling to and from each lesson, which should account for this drop in time. We will again monitor this closely.
